Bridget Yule, director of Student Centers and Programming Services, and chair of the SU White Ribbon Campaign, presented on the campaign, which raises funds for Vera House and also helps to educate the community on sexual and relationship violence. Barry Wells encouraged the Task Force to embrace the campaign. A new Public Service Announcement about the White Ribbon Campaign with Athletic Director Mark Coyle was viewed.

Sarah Scalese reviewed the proposal for the Task Force communication plan and received feedback from the members.
