Susan Pasco described the procedures in place through the Counseling Center for a student who has reported a sexual assault, including confidential and privileged counseling with a staff therapist; explanation of policies, procedures, legal recourse, and financial and insurance concerns; accompaniment and attendance at a hospital emergency room; partnership with a nurse examiner to provide medical care and a forensic exam; and on-going counseling and advocacy. Ben Domingo reported that the Health Center also provides confidential medical care and prophylactic treatment as well as referral to the Counseling Center if desired, although most cases use the Counseling Center as the point of entry.

Samantha Skaller and Pam Peter reviewed the plan for It's On Us Week of Action, beginning with Take Back the Night on March 30 and running through April 8<sup>th</sup> with events every day. Skaller said that this spring the emphasis is on student activism and the events are student driven. Skaller also asked for visible Task Force support of the week, including attending events, wearing the color teal, and signing a banner. Randi Bregman talked about the White Ribbon Campaign, which runs the month of March.
